PROCLAMATION

Recognizing Captain Jeff MacKinnon and the “Death Coast” Salvage Efforts

- WHEREAS:** The Nova Scotian “Death Coast” is an infamously treacherous stretch of the North Atlantic Ocean, home to a staggering estimated 25,000 shipwrecks throughout history; and
- WHEREAS:** Cape Breton’s Captain Jeff MacKinnon, a third-generation shipwreck salvager, has continued his family’s legacy by leading premier recovery efforts of historical artifacts and cultural treasures from these wrecks; and
- WHEREAS:** Captain MacKinnon and his team of ex-FBI, military, and police divers have dedicated themselves to uncovering long-lost artifacts, braving the perils of the North Atlantic in order to document, preserve, and share irreplaceable pieces of maritime history; and
- WHEREAS:** Captain MacKinnon has been granted exclusive rights to dive and salvage in these dangerous waters, providing a once-in-a-generation opportunity to explore shipwrecks of historical and cultural significance; and
- WHEREAS:** “The Death Coast” television series highlights Captain MacKinnon’s mission to recover artifacts of international importance, while promoting local heritage and advancing public knowledge of Nova Scotia’s rich maritime history; and
- WHEREAS:** all artifacts recovered during the series are returned to the Nova Scotia Department of Communities, Culture, Tourism and Heritage, Special Places Protection, ensuring that these artifacts remain preserved for future generations.
