**Subject: Audit Committee Composition**

### **Motion for Council to Consider:**

That Council approve an amendment to the composition of the Audit Committee to include all members of Council, increasing the number of Council representatives from four to the full Council.

### **Rationale:**

This authorization will:

- Increase transparency by involving all members in the direct access to financial oversight discussions
- Increase collective accountability as financial oversight responsibilities are distributed among all members
- Increase clarity as all councillors will participate in audit discussions and have opportunity of receiving information first-hand

### **Outcome Sought:**

Expanding the Audit Committee to include all members of Council is anticipated to further strengthen accountability, transparency, and governance by creating a more inclusive and participatory approach to financial oversight.

The inclusion of all members will promote additional consistency in decision-making, aligning financial management practices with Council's strategic priorities and reinforcing a culture of openness in municipal operations.
